WE BELIEVE


1. We believe in the power of telling stories and having them heard.

WHY GIRLS NEED OUR SUPPORT

The U.S. Surgeon General Dr. Vivek Murthy issued a new Surgeon General's Advisory, *"Protecting Youth Mental Health,"* in which he writes, "The challenges today's generation of young people face are unprecedented and uniquely hard to navigate... Over 50% of female students report persistent feelings of sadness or hopelessness."

In *The Atlantic* article, "How Puberty Kills Girls' Confidence," the author Claire Shipman writes that while all teens experience a blow to their confidence during adolescence, "**it's nothing like what teenage girls experience.**"

Recent studies on self-esteem show:


7 in 10 girls believe that they are "not good enough."

- 75% of girls with low self-esteem reported engaging in self-harming activities like cutting, drinking, drug use, or disordered eating.
- 1 in 4 girls today fall into a clinical diagnosis depression, eating disorders, cutting, or other mental/emotional disorders.

1 in 3 girls report feeling constantly anxious, sleep deprived, and under significant pressure.

OUR IMPACT SO FAR

Since 2013, we have facilitated over 4,000 hours of classes and workshops for over 400 girls and gender-expansive youth, publishing over 750 pieces of student writing and four printed anthologies. Most of our students write with us every week and every year until they leave for college. Over time, our writers learn to see themselves as the authors and leaders of their own lives—and that changes everything.

TUITION & CLASS STRUCTURE

The Intuitive Writing Project is dedicated to serving every girl who loves to write and wants to write with us.

The transformative power of our programs comes from their 6:1 student/teacher ratio. This ensures that every girl receives personalized mentoring and support. *The true cost* of our programs is reflected in Tier 1 pricing. With the help of our corporate and community partners, we now aim to offer Tier 2 (partial scholarship) and Tier 3 (full scholarship) pricing, as well. At least 85% of our expenses go to program services.

Tier 1 The true cost of our programs

Middle school programs: Class length: 90 minutes Class size: 4-6 \$70/class

High school programs: Class length: 2 hours Class size: 4-6 \$90/class

Tier 2 Tuition for middle-income families
